

GARDEN AFTER DARK COSTUME POLICY

Proper attire, including shoes and shirts, must be worn at all times. Garden After Dark is a casual, family-oriented environment. Ensuring the event is family-friendly is an important part of the experience. In that spirit, we ask all guests to use discretion and common sense when it comes to costumes.

While we encourage creativity, we also value safety and good judgement. Please note the following rules and regulations:

General Guidelines

- Red Butte Garden reserves the right to deny admission to or remove any person wearing attire the Garden, in its sole discretion, considers to be inappropriate or that could detract from the experience of other guests.
- Costumes must be family-friendly and may not be obstructive, offensive, objectionable, or violent.
- Costumes may not contain any pretend weapons that resemble or could easily be mistaken for an actual weapon.
- Costumes may not contain sharp objects, pointed objects, or materials that may accidentally strike another guest.
- Guests who do not adhere to these guidelines may be refused entry into or removed from the event, unless his or her costume/accessory can be modified to meet the above standards.

Guidelines for Guest Ages 13 and Under

- Costumes and some masks may be worn, as long as the mask does not cover the entire face and eyes are visible.

Guidelines for Guest Ages 14 and Older

- Layered costumes or costume props that surround the entire body are strongly discouraged and may be subject to additional security screening.
- Themed T-shirts, blouses, sweatshirts, and hats are acceptable.
- Headwear may be worn as long as it does not cover the face.
- Masks of any kind may NOT be worn.
- Face paint of any kind is NOT permitted.
